This bathroom is centered on a wide window, with the tub dead-center beneath its sill and the vanities flanking each side. The shower and toilet-stalls form bookend glass cubes between which one must pass to approach the window. The only off-center element is a tiled cube bench intersected by the glass shower partition. Lots of storage is offered in the vanities and at the back wall.



There are two other bathrooms in the house, which are more utilitarian, but they borrow some of the glamour of the master bath by repeating its finishes and details.



This dressing room attached to the bathroom is a contrast to the light-filled bathroom. The chandelier marks the crossing of the axis of the closet and the entry from the bathroom.
